
WMOC2017 Competition terrain 1(3)

- All three competitions are organized from one competition centre, which is situated 16 km to the east from the Hamina Garrison.
- Highway E18 borders the competition area from the southern side and the area of Fin5 2016 orienteering week from the northern side.

WMOC2017 Competition terrain 2(3)

 The terrain is mainly pine forests with good visibility but also spruce forest areas with lower visibility. Runability is mainly very good, because Hamina is part of rapakivi granite area which means the stones and cliffs have undergone erosion over the course of a very long time. Therefore and also because of the Ice Age, there are a lot of stones and small knolls on map but surface under foot is not too stony.





WMOC2017 Competition terrain 3(3)


- A mixture of hills, detailed contour areas, marshes, fast open bare-rock areas and greener areas offers many different orienteering challenges.
- The main competition area was mapped for the national orienteering competition in 1976.
